Breathing:

with gills then lungs

cold blooded

Babies:

lay jelly-like eggs

Examples:

frog, toad, salamander

Bird

Body Covering:

feathers

Breathing:

lungs

Blood:

warm blooded

Babies:

lay hard eggs

Examples:

robin, eagle

Fish

Body Covering:

scales

Breathing:

gills

Blood:

cold blooded

Babies:

lay eggs (mostly)

Examples:

bass, sharks, tuna, sea horses

Mammal

Body Covering:

hair or fur

Breathing:

lungs

Blood:

warm blooded

Babies:

give birth to live young

Examples:

tiger, dolphin, whale

Reptile

Body Covering:

dry scales or plates

Breathing:

lungs

Blood:

cold blooded

Babies:

lay eggs (mostly)

Examples:

turtle, snake, crocodile, lizard
